Refund Policy			

Application, enrollment and registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable from one student to another or from one school year to another. Tuition is non-transferable from one student to another or from one school year to another. Tuition is non-refundable unless one of the following criteria applies:

- If withdrawal occurs before the first day of school, there will be a 100 percent refund of tuition monies paid.
- As of the first day of school, refunds will be given for the following reasons only:
 - Medical withdrawal of the student for any physical disability certified to and treated by a legally qualified medical practitioner.
 - Job related transfer of parent or guardian beyond a 50-mile radius of the Gillette. Documentation of such transfer is required if a refund is requested.
- If withdrawal occurs as of or after the first day of school, and one of the above criteria (1 or 2) applies, tuition will be refunded prorated to the end of the current nine-week quarter.
- No Refund will be given if monies are owed on any other account. The amount owed must be paid first, or will be deducted from the refund due.
- When a student withdraws from Heritage Christian School (for any reason), a letter of explanation is required to request any refund which applies.

PHILOSOPHY

A philosophy is created when a person makes a decision based upon a pattern of beliefs.

One's concept of truth, God and purpose interact to provide a viewpoint by which all else shall be evaluated and interpreted. For the Christian whose view point is centered in the Word of God, the philosophy of education is a Christ-centered, theistic world-view approach in which God is the key figure. The basic concepts of this Christ-centered philosophy of education are:

By signing at the bottom, I am stating that I agree the school's philosophy.

- 1. God is the Creator and Sustainer of the universe. He is in control of His universe at all times.
- 2. God is the source of all truth.
- 3. Man is by nature a sinner, separated from God, attempting to place himself at the center of all creation, denying God His rightful place as "King of Kings and Lord of Lords."
- 4. Man's reconciliation to God can only be affected through faith in the shed blood of Christ who died to pay the penalty for sin.

 This regeneration (salvation, born again, conversion) by faith in Jesus Christ allow man to understand true values based in His person, purpose and work.
- 5. God has established three mean of revealing Himself and His truth to man: Creation, the Bible, and His Son Jesus Christ.

 Creation, God's world, presents a general revelation of His character. The Bible and His Son present a specific revelation of His character and truth, necessary for the working of His will in the lives of all who will accept His truth.
- 6. The education and training of a child are the parents' responsibility in which the Christian school and the church should provide a complimentary function. The church and the school cannot replace the responsibility of the parent.
- 7. The Christian home, school and church should work together to promote spiritual growth, academic excellence, physical fitness and social graces in the children. (Luke 2:52)
- 8. The teacher stands in the place of the parent (in loco parentis) as a figure of authority and discipline while the student is at school
- 9. The teachers have the responsibility to attempt to meet the needs of all children according to their individual ability.
- 10. The Christian is to be in the world, but not of it. As Paul stated, "be not conformed (pressed) into the mold of this world."

 However, the Christian must share in his responsibility as a citizen to guide and direct society according to the will of God.

 (Romans 12:2a)
- 11. In order to be different from the world, one must be "transformed by the renewing of the mind" a primary function of Christian education. (Romans 12:2b)
- 12. The primary preparation of a person through his experience in the home, church, and school should be for a life of fellowship with, and service to, God; a combination which will affect his fellow man.
- 13. The Spirit filled life is the only life which is pleasing to God and produces spiritual fruit for both here and for the hereafter.

 This life involves the reality of personal fellowship with God through His Word, prayer and service.

Heritage Christian School Statement of Faith
1. WE BELIEVE the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God. (2 Timothy 3:12, 2 Peter 1:21)
2. WE BELIEVE there is only one God, eternally existent in three persons; Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:2, Matthew 28.19, John 19:30)
3. WE BELIEVE in the deity on Christ (John 10:33); His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35); His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, Hebrews 7:26); His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9); His resurrection (John 11:25, I Corinthians 15:4); His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); and His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11)
4. WE BELIEVE in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature; and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ, and that only by God's grace alone through faith are we saved. (John 3:16-19, John 5:24, Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8-9, Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5)
5. WE BELIEVE in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29)
6. WE BELEIVE in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:13-14; I Corinthians 12:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28
7. WE BELIEVE in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life. (Roman 8:13-14, I Corinthians 3:16, I Corinthians 6:19-20, Ephesians 4:30 & 5:18)
8. WE BELIEVE that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male and female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Gen 1:26-27). Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person. We believe that the term marriage has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture (Genesis 2:18-25). We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other (I Corinthians 6:18, 7:2-5; Hebrews 13:4). We believe that God's command is that there be no sexual intimacy outside of or apart from marriage between a man and a woman. We believe that God wonderfully foreordained and immutably created each person as either male or female in conformity with their biological sex. These two distinct yet complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Genesis 1:26-27) The board members and faculty of Heritage Christian School have committed themselves to the above Statement of Faith, and it

Since the inception of Heritage Christian School, it has been the desire of the board that the inter-denominational position of the school be stressed and maintained. The Statement of Faith is fundamental to the basic Christian tenets, and contains those doctrines to which we unreservedly adhere and teach.

In some areas of doctrine, such as the ones below, the faculty shall have the liberty to academically state their belief (which is in accord with the Statement of Faith). They shall qualify their statements with the reminder that there are differences of opinion among born again believers, and that the student is reminded to discuss these issues with their parents and pastor. We respect the right of students and parents to hold differing beliefs in these matters:

- Church government (authority and discipline)
- Time and mode of baptism
- Security of the believer
- Time of the rapture

- Second work of grace (baptism of the Holy Spirit)
- Sinless perfection
- Gifts of the Spirit (tongues, interpretation of tongues, healing, miracle working, prophecy, discerning of spirits)

Any parents seeking to influence "denominational change" of the type spoken above may be asked to withdraw their children. The school is not to be used as a recruiting ground. There are times, however, when you may have contact with someone who is not saved (i.e. he or she has never accepted Christ as personal Savior). Because this is not "denominationalism", we encourage you to pray for them and wisely present the Gospel to them, that they may come to know Him, who is life everlasting. We desire to remain united in the salvation and love of Christ, avoiding the dissension of denominational problems.

POSITION STATEMENT ABOUT BIBLE TRANSLATIONS AND THE KJV:

Heritage Christian School is a non-denominational school. This means that students will be coming from different doctrinal viewpoints. HCS families, staff, and chapel speakers are required to not discuss or teach about these 7 points of doctrine:

- 1. Church government (authority and discipline)
- 2. Time and mode of baptism
- 3. Security of the believer
- 4. Time of the rapture
- 5. Second work of grace (baptism of the Holy Spirit)
- 6. Sinless perfection
- 7. Gifts of the Spirit (tongues, interpretation of tongues, healing, miracle working, prophecy, and/or discerning of spirits)

We leave instruction on those matters to parents and the pastors of our students. Similarly, parents are free to choose which Bible version they prefer their children to study and/or memorize from. We do not debate Bible translations at HCS.

The Christian curriculums we use are all available in the KJV: ABeka, Alpha-Omega, A.C.E., and Bob Jones University Press. Primary grade teachers may at times use a children's illustrated Bible, children's story Bible, or children's translation as an aid to their Bible lesson or to practice reading or writing skills. At no time will students be required to memorize from such materials.

Upper grades will need a KJV Bible for their Bible workbook assignments. They may choose to use an easier translation to read long passages. All families may use their own choice of Bible translation for required Bible memorization assignments.
